**I.** There were 35 dairy cows and 10 beef cows in the barn. All pens are covered and in an enclosed barn to protect livestock from inclement weather. Weather was 87F and sunny. Windows were open and fans were on.

**II.** Four dairy cows were unloaded by the driver from a gooseneck trailer with a minimum of excitement and discomfort. No implements were used. The trailer was parked squarely against the unloading dock.

**III.** Water was available in all pens via automatic water troughs. Hay was provided in feeders to cattle that had been held over 24 hours.

**IV.** The pens, driveways, and ramps were maintained in good repair. Floors were maintained so as to provide adequate footing and were clear of manure.

**V.** No suspect or disabled animals were present during the odd hour inspection.

**VI.** No prods or other objects were used during unloading and while penning livestock.

**VII.** No slips and falls were noted during unloading and while penning livestock.

**VIII.** No animals were stunned during the odd hour inspection.

**IX.** No animals were stunned during the odd hour inspection.
