At approximately 11:55 AM while performing HATS Category II, Truck Unloading, a group of cows and bulls from NoPlace (establishment receiving number 000) were unloaded (transported by NoTransport). There was a bull in the top corner unable to stand and be unloaded from the trailer. His left hind leg/foot was stuck in the floor (weld/bolts broke during transportation) of the trailer (top) and wedged in a gap under a ramp/compartment leading to the nose of the trailer. Barn Lead NoName was able to humanely pry the broken floor to create a larger gap, which allowed the bull to free his leg. The bull's leg was sore (not fully weight-bearing) and was missing a declaw; however, there were no open cuts seen on his leg and no signs of swelling. The bull passed ante-mortem inspection. I notified Barn Lead NoName that the trailer needed to be repaired prior to hauling any livestock. He informed First Last, Meat Assignment.
