SOP: Protocol to create AER File for HH Allegations

This SOP provides direction to OFO personnel when a Humane Handling (HH) allegation is made by an individual or organization. OFO is to maintain documentation concerning the HH allegation in Assurance Net within an AER File.

- Upon receipt of a humane handling allegation, the Humane Handling Enforcement Coordinator (HHEC) will communicate this information to the respective district office by email and include the documents sent.
- 2. The HHEC will request the DO to open an AER file specific to the allegation and complete an OFO investigation
- 3. Upon receipt of the email from HHEC, the DCS or DO designee will create an appropriate AER file.
- 4. Under the "General" tab,
 - a) In the "Reason for AER Initiation" Text box, enter the exact sentence: Humane Handling Allegation from (name of person or organization making allegation) for a livestock establishment and Good Commercial Practices Allegation from (name of person or organization making allegation) for a poultry establishment.
 - b) For the "Type of AER" select "Other" as the category.
- 5. Under the "Evidence Collected" tab, include the following documents, if applicable:
 - a) Allegation (letter or email as applicable)
 - b) Documentation from HHEC to district requesting AER file creation for HH allegation
 - c) Most recent HHVV or GCP Assessment report
 - d) Relevant HH documents recent MOIs; NRs, etc.
 - e) Notification by Criminal Investigations Division within OIEA when case has been closed by CID or referred for further investigation
 - f) Documentation of the investigation and its results
- 6. If OFO investigation of HH allegation results in an Enforcement Action, a new AER file will be created following usual protocol, linking both cases together under the "Past/Related AER" tab.
- 7. Under the "File Attachments" tab,
 - a. Upload the letter by OPACE providing the official FSIS response to the HH allegation
 - b. In text box, identify uploaded file as official FSIS response to the HH allegation
- 8. District closes out file
